Here's how to register for camp 2022:

1. Print Registration Form
2. Fully Complete Page 1
3. Fully complete Registration form page 2-3 (**Only send in if applicable**)
4. Copy and attach child's vaccination records (or include a note from doctor for medical exemption.) If your child was here last year and has had no new vaccines you do not need to send again, check box "No new vaccinations since last year."

We are state licensed and must follow state guidelines for our monitoring.

*Registration sent without updated Vaccination Records or Medical Exemption Letter will not be registered and no spot will be held until application is complete. If child has an upcoming physical prior to camp starting, please send the current records to get child registered, and then send in update once you have it.

5. **Mail registration form: On or after February 15th,** with vaccination record and check made out to "Soulshine Farm". **Checks are cashed on May 15st.**

**Special Social/Behavioral/Learning Needs/Separation Anxiety:**

1. All children must exhibit the following behavioral requirements. Be able to:
  - A. Be present without engaging in unsafe or disruptive behaviors
  - B. Be able and willing to follow instructions (with support as needed)
  - C. Be able/willing to participate in full & small group activities, (with support as needed)
  - D. Be independent in toileting.

Do you believe your child will be able to achieve the behavioral requirements? Are there supports that must be in place to help your child achieve the behavioral requirements? How can we help? What do you find helpful at home? What modifications or strategies are used in school?

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2. Please describe your child’s current educational setting, including information on type of classroom (inclusion or special education), level of support (does your child have his/her own aide in the classroom or a shared aide), teacher:student ratio, size of the class. Will this be the same for the coming school years? This information helps with staffing so that we can provide for the comfort, needs, and safety of all children.

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3. If your child has an aide in school and it is determined that an aide is needed for camp, the aide must be selected from Soulshine Farm Camp’s list of approved aides. Also, we have found it helpful for us to have a conversation with teacher and/or aide from most recently completed school year, to gather strategies to help child succeed. Once we review your application, we will contact you to determine what resources are necessary and if we are able to meet your child’s needs.

It is our goal that every child who attends our camp has a joyful experience.

If your child is unable/unwilling to follow safety rules (with support in place), is a danger to self of others, or is disrespectful to staff, other campers, animals, or property, and; if we feel we have tried reasonable strategies to help them be successful at camp, but challenging behaviors continue, your child may be asked to withdraw from camp. (This has only occurred 3 times in 14 yrs of camp.)

The unused days will be refunded minus \$75 for administration costs/time.
